Dept. of Computer Science of YCMOU, Nashik offers research level M.Phil. Degree programs. These M.Phil. programs are of 1½ -2 years' duration. Specifically, in 2nd year of the M. Phil. Degree program, students are required to work on research projects. One important outcome of offering of Information Integrity System (IIS) course under YCMOU's M. Phil. degree is that from the first (i.e., 2006-08) batch of M.Phil. students, in 2007-08, total 11 M. Phil. students – both from IT as well as Computer Science disciplines - have opted to do their research projects in I*I area.

During the CIIR activity-reporting period, presently under consideration, i. e., during the period August 6, 2007 - October 13, 2007, one major activity undertaken was planning for these 11 M. Phil. students' I*I area research projects. Deliberations at IIRETM2007 formed an useful input in this planning. Specifically, Prof. Mandke had a number of research interactions during the period at Pune and Mumbai with the students interested in I*I based topics and, as a result, following students have identified M.Phil. research projects in I*I as mentioned here.
