

CIIR ACTIVITIES

23 March 2008 – 3 November 2008

Within the framework of I*I education and research activities through 2006-08, CIIR Activities during period 23 March 2008 – 3 November 2008 are devoted to the tasks of implementation and further continuation and expansion of I*I education at UG level for B.E. (Electronics) degree at University of Pune (UoP), Pune and at PG level for M.Phil. (IT) degree at YCMOU University, Nashik through activities of: course lectures' workshops for students, counseling, examinations' work, planning for student seminars, planning for I*I research & education in the coming semester, etc.

Thus, till August in 2008,

- 503 UG electrical engineering students attended UG level I*I education involving 10 teachers at 10 engineering colleges across the State of Maharashtra,
- 60 teachers of IT/CS discipline programs in various Science colleges in the State of Maharashtra attended PG level research course *IIS* at 4 study centers of YCMOU University, Nashik, and
- 27 management degree students attended PG level I*I education at IMT, Ghaziabad.

Further, in 2008, 10 M.Phil. (IT) students (of 2007 batch of YCMOU University, Nashik) pursued I*I research projects in partial fulfillment of their M.Phil. (IT) degree requirements.
